Answer: Since 2011 we pay 25 € each semester for the opportunity to drive through Weimar by bus as often as we want. Now we have to decide whether we want to continue this contractual relationship. Question: How is the procedure of the election?
Answer: At those places mentioned above you can get informed about the candidates of your faculty. Then you can place five votes on your ballot paper for one or more candidates, but only for those ones of your faculty.

Question: Who are the members of Student's Council and how can I be a part of it?
Answer: There are twelve students in every Student's Council, of which we have four (one for each faculty). To become a member of your Council, you need to run as a candidate for the election. You can do that by filling in the form on the right page. If you get elected, you are a member for one year and may also work in other university committees, if you want to.
